Mission

What We Do

Women In Energy helps achieve energy efficiency and popularize use of solar energy. We provide training, consultancy and support to help people make their homes energy efficient and also encourage them install solar systems. WIE focuses on providing support to foster energy conservation methods and awareness plans.

Networking

Women in Energy is endeavouring to network with all stakeholders. This includes Ministry of Environment, USAID, GTZ, Public & Private Sector Universities / Colleges and energy sector organizations involved in generation, distribution, conservation and renewables.

Initiatives

On Grid Solar System

Pakistan's first On-Grid solar project is in progress. This is a break through Project as tariff will be determined and electricity generation will be formalized by connecting it to the National Grid.

People will have a choice to have their own alternative source of Energy and their excess load available will be put on grid. This will also open venue for private investment into this sector.

JICA has approved a 100KW solar system for Pakistan Engineering Council Building. Engr. Senator Rukhsana Zuberi, Chairperson PEC and her solar energy team initiated the project to generate solar energy for 6 storied PEC building.

Energy Efficiency Measures

After taking the charge of Chairperson, PEC, in August 2008, Engr Senator Rukhsana Zuberi directed to take energy efficiency measures at Pakistan Engineering Council head office to reduce its share in carbon emissions. Energy efficiency is being ensured by putting energy efficient lights and fixtures. Building interior is being modified to benefit from maximum daylight. Half of the office space has already undergone exercise for conserving energy reducing consumption by 30%.

Engr. Senator Rukhsana Zuberi is also Chairperson of Women in Energy and has assumed the responsibility to create awareness about this On-Grid Project.
